

The following rules and regulations are for the benefit and protection of all players:

- Courts are reserved for Chapel Gate Members and their registered guests.
- Each household can occupy at most one court at a time.
- Members are not required to make a reservation to play, but reservations take precedence over walk-up play.
- Courts are now reserved through Chapel Gate's membership software. Please see instructions link for reserving courts on our website.
- Players with court reservations are expected to keep their reservation or cancel in a timely manner.
- Courts are solely for tennis and pickleball.
- All Players are required to wear tennis shoes with non-marking soles. Bare feet, sandals and street shoes are not permitted on the courts.
- The following are reasons for dismissal from the courts:
 - Do not abuse nets or other equipment
 - Smoking
 - No glass drinks of any kind
 - No bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, strollers or camp chairs
 - Unsportsmanlike conduct, including profanity or racket throwing
 - Improper attire or improperly soled shoes
 - Inappropriate behavior towards Chapel Gate staff or other members and guests
- If you are the last person to leave the courts, lock up behind yourself even if it isn't evening.
- Lights must be out by 11 pm, and you must confirm that lights are out before leaving.
- Repeated and intentional violation of rules could result in suspended access to the courts and/or the reservation system.
